

## FOR MINISTERS:

1. Enormously time-saving -  
30 x 1 hour sessions replaced by  
1 x 2½ hour sessions (a saving of 27½ hours a week).  
Redeems the time for the Christian minister (Eph.5:15-16)
2. Also avoids lengthy interviews and discussions and never-ending counselling sessions. Gets down to "DOING" rather than "TALKING". (1 Cor.4:20)(James 1:22-25).
3. More enjoyable format, with plenty of PRAISE and opportunity for the WORD, prophecy etc. Refreshing - not normally exhausting or more draining than a one-on-one session (Neh.8:10, Isaiah 40:31). Certainly much less draining than 30 single sessions!
4. Greatly increases anointing on/of the ministers - authority, power, discernment etc.
5. Gives freedom to the Holy Spirit to deal with each person individually and personally - and powerfully (John 3:8).  
God is therefore not limited to the limitations of the flesh of His servants (1 Sam.14:6)(Revelation of T.L. Osborn).
6. "Confines" the ministry to a set time and place, to which needy enquirers can be invited. Choosing the battleground! This avoids many untimely interruptions to a minister's work-day (emergencies excepted).
7. Makes ministry available to ALL Christians without discrimination or embarrassment:  
(Rom.2:11      Acts 10:34)  
(Eph.6:9      God is no respecter of persons)  
(Col.3:25      James 2)
