

THE RIGHT ATTITUDE TO RECEIVING DELIVERANCE

1. The *sincerity* of the sufferer in desiring the ministry, and the ability to stand firm in the Word of God regardless of all discouragement by well-meaning Pastors and Christians, or false brethren, who have not caught the vision, etc. (Eph. 6:10-14, James 5:7-11, Phil. 3:2,17-4:1). Also, the sufferer's ability to:-
2. *Catch the revelation of God* about sin and demons, and the extent of our infection, i.e. to understand something of the PROBLEM. (Eph. 2:2, 6:12, Matt. 12:38-45).
3. *KNOW when they are manifesting* uncleanness (Matt. 15:18-20), and immediately -
4. *Bring their spiritual, Christian weapons into operation* when they are under spiritual attack (i.e., manifesting). For example, Praise, Prayer, Authority, Word, etc. Their cassette players should be worn out with PRAISE tapes! (1 Cor. 12:4-11, Eph. 6:14-18, James 4:7-8, Phil. 4:4-9).
5. *Cope with manifestations and actual deliverance day by day* in the context of their ongoing daily responsibilities in the home and at work. (Rom. 8:31-39, Phil. 1:27-30, 3:12-17, 4:13).
6. *Follow the counselling* given, putting away and overruling all rebellious inclinations (Heb. 13:7, 17; Phil. 2:12-13), knowing that their source within them is unclean (Eph. 2:2). Such counsel, of course, should only be that which is necessary for effective deliverance ministry, and provided the sufferer can see the need for whatever is counselled the minister can usually obtain their co-operation.
