

7. It is written of John the Baptist that:

...he came into all the district around the Jordan, preaching a baptism of repentance for forgiveness of sins; as it is written in the book of the words of Isaiah the prophet, "The voice of one crying in the wilderness,

'MAKE READY THE WAY OF THE LORD. MAKE HIS PATHS STRAIGHT. EVERY RAVINE SHALL BE FILLED UP, AND EVERY MOUNTAIN AND HILL SHALL BE BROUGHT LOW; AND THE CROOKED SHALL BECOME STRAIGHT, AND THE ROUGH ROADS SMOOTH; AND ALL FLESH SHALL SEE THE SALVATION OF GOD.'

He therefore began saying to the multitudes who were going out to be baptized by him, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

Therefore bring forth fruits in keeping with your repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham for our fathers,' for I say to you that God is able from these stones to raise up children to Abraham.

"And also the axe is already laid at the root of the trees; every tree therefore that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire". (Luke 3:4-9)
